



# Inflatable Rescue Boat Crew

## Course Description

The aim of this course is to provide participants with the skills and knowledge to effectively crew an Inflatable Rescue Boat (IRB) in surf rescue operations.

## Award

Upon successful completion of this course participants will receive the SLSA Inflatable Rescue Boat Crew award.

## Course content

- Demonstrate pre-operation procedures
- Crew an Inflatable Rescue Boat
- Perform emergency drills
- Conduct IRB rescues, search and recovery
- Demonstrate post operation service and storage

## Entry Requirements

- Participants must be a minimum of 15 years of age on the date of final assessment.
- Participants must meet the following SLSA requirements:
  - Hold a current SLSA Bronze Medallion/Certificate II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue)

## General Information

The duration of the course is approximately 8-10 sessions.

## Assessment

Assessment is through demonstration, presentation and application of all elements of competency in the work-place. Participants will be required to complete activities that may include role-plays, oral and written questioning, practical demonstrations and performing scenarios.
